If you see something wrong, stop and try to address the situation as it could affect your riding privileges. This means even in the summer and fall keep your eyes open; talk to your neighbors and friends to see what you can do to help for your own access to the trails. Times have changed and unfortunately the neighbor's farm may not be run the way your father's or neighbor's was. HVR has had to try to repair damages caused by others and we should not have to do this. If we all keep an eye out and be open to others likes and dislikes, we can all find common ground and have a successful and prosperous trail system.

EQUIPMENT:

We approved the purchase of a 2006 Terra Track Range Runner (All-Terrain Utility Vehicle). The unit will be used for grooming and year round trail maintenance.
