There are several ways to join our club: 1) Complete this form and mail it to the secretary and you'll get your voucher in about 3 weeks. 2) Visit our website, click on "Join Our Club Online", pay by credit card and print out your voucher instantly. 3) Download and print out a membership form from our website and mail it in. 4) Join at any monthly meeting.

In order to save \$55 per sled registration, you will need to join a snowmobile club. When you become a member of a club you will receive a voucher. This voucher proves your club standing. Submit the voucher with your sled registration to the DMV and you'll receive the reduced rate. Upon becoming a member of a snowmobile club your information is entered in to a database that NYSSA sponsors. This database also proves your club standing. This database is **only** accessible to the snowmobile club you join, NYSSA and the DMV.

**Individual memberships/vouchers** are issued to single individuals. There is no cap on the amount of sleds one can register as long as each sled is registered to the same individual and address and the individual is a member of a club.

Family memberships/vouchers will be issued to families described as husband/wife and their children. Children must be 17 years of age or younger and must have the same address and have a snowmobile registered in their own name. There is no cap on the amount of sleds one can register per membership as long as each sled is registered to the same address. It also doesn't matter if sleds are registered in different names as long as each person and their registration share the same address and are shown as a member of a club.

Business memberships work the same way as family memberships. It is important to complete the membership form and list owners/officers of a business and their family accordingly. Business members receive advertising space on our map. Please submit a current business card and be sure to mail your information in by October 31, 2022. DO NOT REGISTER ONLINE. IF DONE ONLINE, THERE IS NO BUSINESS CHARGE RATE THAT CAN BE APPLIED. PLEASE MAIL IN YOUR REGISTRATION INFORMATION AND CURRENT BUSINESS CARD.

**Business Landowners** receive the Hill and Valley Riders Club and NYSSA membership FREE and only pay \$30 for advertising space on our map.

**Landowners** receive FREE Hill and Valley Riders Club and NYSSA membership. By giving permission for seasonal access to the club, the landowner is protected by the provisions of the NYS General Obligations law. If you would like proof of the clubs liability insurance please check the box to let us know how to send the certificate to you.

With your paid HVR membership, you will receive a voucher for registration purposes, NYSSA membership with all its benefits, our map in December, newsletters and post cards listing upcoming trail improvement work schedules and events. If you provide your e-mail address, you may be contacted about upcoming trail work and events.
